Judge Lorenzo Patiño was born in Juarez, Mexico, one of eight children. He came to the Sacramento area as a young boy, attended local schools and graduated as the only Latino of the graduating class from UC Davis School of Law in the early 1970's.

As a young lawyer he worked in state politics, charitable organizations and as adviser to US Presidents on immigration policy.

In 1980 Lorenzo Patiño was appointed to the Municipal Court of Sacramento by then Gov. Brown. He worked with colleagues to establish the University Of Northern California Law School prior to losing his battle with leukemia in 1984. In a short life, Judge Lorenzo Patiño succeeded in doing much for the Latino Community.
